

Florida's Voter ID Rules

Voting in Person

Florida asks for photo ID to vote in person.

Your ID must have your photo and signature. If it doesn't have your signature, bring extra ID that does.

You can use:

Must be unexpired

- FL driver's license
- FL state ID card
- US passport
- Military ID
- Student ID
- Public assistance ID
- Veterans health ID card issued by VA
- Retirement center ID
- Neighborhood association ID
- Debit or credit card
- FL concealed weapon or firearm license
- Employee ID issued by US government, state of FL, or local government

Voting by Mail

Any registered Florida voter can vote by mail. Voters must request an absentee ballot for each 2-year election cycle. Request now for 2026!

You need to provide one of the following numbers when you request your ballot:

- FL driver's license number
- FL state ID card number
- Last 4 digits of your Social Security number

You do not need to include ID when you return your vote-by-mail ballot.

2026 Primary Election

Voter Registration Deadline: July 20

Deadline to Request Mail Ballot: August 6

Statewide Early Voting: Aug. 8 - Aug. 15
(Same-day registration available during early voting!)

Election Day: August 18
