

Ohio's Voter ID Rules

Voting in Person

Ohio requires photo ID to vote.

You can use:

Must be unexpired

- OH driver's license
- OH state ID card
- US passport or passport card
- Military ID issued by OH National Guard or US government
- US Veterans Affairs ID card
- Interim ID form issued by BMV

Voting by Mail

Any registered Ohio voter can vote by mail.

You must provide an ID number or a copy of an accepted unexpired ID with **BOTH** your absentee ballot application **and** your completed ballot.

You can use one of the following:

- OH driver's license number
- OH state ID card number
- Last 4 digits of Social Security number
- Copy of accepted photo ID

Voter Registration Deadline: April 6

Deadline to Request Mail Ballot: April 28

Early Voting: April 7 - May 3

Election Day: May 5
