

Georgia's Voter ID Rules

Voting in Person

Georgia requires photo ID to vote.

You can use:

Ok if expired

- GA driver's license

Must be unexpired

- GA state ID card
- ID issued by US government or any state
- GA Voter ID card
- US passport or passport card
- Student ID from public GA college or university approved by GA Secretary of State
- Tribal ID
- Military ID
- Employee ID issued by US, GA, or local government

Voting by Mail

Any registered Georgia voter can vote by mail.

You need to provide one of the following when you request your absentee ballot:

- GA driver's license number
- GA state ID card number

If you do not have one of these numbers, provide:

- Copy of accepted photo ID
- Copy of utility bill, bank statement, paycheck, government check or government document with your name and address

You must also provide an ID number or copy of ID when you return your absentee ballot!

2026 Primary Election

Voter Registration Deadline: April 20

Deadline to Request Mail Ballot: May 8

Statewide Early Voting: April 27 - May 15

Election Day: May 19
